



SDG 7 - ENSURE ACCESS TO AFFORDABLE, RELIABLE, SUSTAINABLE AND MODERN ENERGY FOR ALL

INTERNAL ACTIONS

- adopt a corporate energy policy that establishes guidelines on the access to and use of energy;
- train employees and suppliers about energy efficiency and distribute guidelines defining how to save on consumption in offices and factories;
- use renewable energy sources in corporate activities, also making the relevant changes to the business model;
- monitor the energy consumption related to employees' business trips;
- invest in energy efficiency throughout the supply chain, for example by supporting the reduction of energy consumption connected to the transport of products and services;
- adopt certified energy management systems;
- install energy-efficient technologies;
- guarantee decent working conditions throughout the supply chain, ensuring that workers have access to electrical systems in the workplace and a salary that is sufficient to enable them and their families to use electricity in their own homes.

EXTERNAL ACTIONS

- use company products and services to find solutions to facilitate access for everyone to safe, sustainable, and modern sources of energy. For example, a firm in the energy sector can undertake the construction of solar panels for the use of rural communities;
- spread good practices related to energy efficiency and the use of renewable energy sources;
- support and/or participate in development cooperation projects focused on the energy sector;
- enable public-private partnerships with NGOs, governments and local authorities, and other companies to promote access to energy for everyone and spread the use of renewable energy.
